ON TRACK CONNECT

Steps to receive On Track Connect support:

- Fill in the form "On Track" the school provides to you at the start of the year.
- In April-May you will be contacted to complete an online survey on your job or study status. When completing the survey you can **request further assistance**
- In June-August NMLLEN will contact you to provide further assistance **if you requested it** (support is up to 3 months)

Transition to Work is an employment service to support young people aged 15-24 on their journey to employment. The service provides intensive, pre-employment support to improve the work-readiness of young people and help them into work (including apprenticeships and traineeships) or education.

Our local Transition to Work provider Axis Employment have experience working with disengaged and disadvantaged young people and have strong links with employers, community services and schools in their local community.

How does Jobactive help job seekers?

Jobactive provides eligible job seekers with access to tailored help from a jobactive provider, based on their assessed needs.

This could include:

- help looking for work
- writing a résumé and preparing for interviews
- referrals to jobs in their local area
- training that is suited to the skills that local employers need
- case management so that job seekers are ready to take up and keep a job
- support to complete Work for the Dole or other eligible activities to provide them with work-like experiences, to help job seekers learn new skills and improve their chances of finding a job.
